ENTRY FEE

All entrants to the Rapidplay are required to be members of the English Chess Federation (ECF) at Gold level. Bronze or non-members will pay a surcharge of £15.00 on top of the basic entry fee of £25.00 (£22.00 juniors).

Non-ENG PLAYERS who belong to a FIDE nation other than ENG (e.g. SCO or USA) don't need to belong to the ECF but it will cost them more to play. HOWEVER you do need to quote a FIN (FIDE Identification Number) with your entry. Non-English players will have to obtain a FIN from their national federation in good time prior to the tournament otherwise you cannot enter.

LATE ENTRIES

Space at the playing venue is limited. Please enter early to avoid disappointment and to aid administration. Entries submitted after 25 August 2025 will only be accepted at the Organiser's discretion and will be subject to a £5.00 surcharge.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SECTIONS

Eligibility for sections in the Rapidplay event will be based on the highest rating a player has from the following options:

FIDE RAPIDPLAY RATING (AUGUST 2025)

ECF RAPIDPLAY RATING (AUGUST 2025) — A or K categories only

The higher of the Aug 2025 FIDE and ECF Blitz ratings will be used when determining rating prizes in that event.

For players without any of these ratings, section eligibility and the rating allocated for pairings will be determined by the Organiser on a case-by-case basis. Seedings and pairings within Sections will be based on the most up-to-date ratings available.

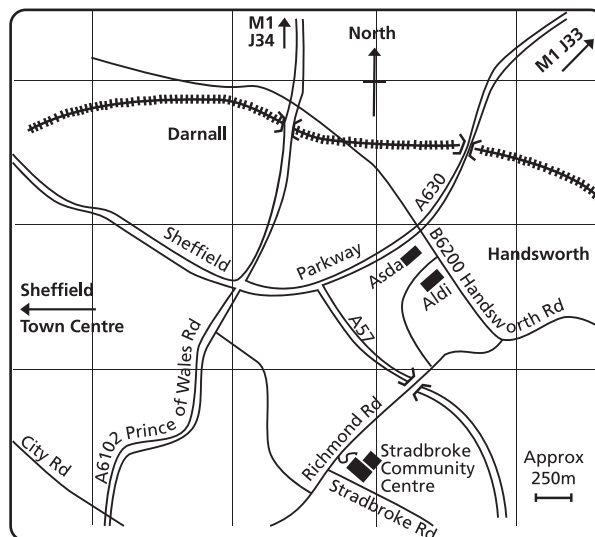
ACCESSIBILITY

HOW TO FIND US

BY CAR

FROM M1 — At junction 33 head towards Sheffield along the A630. Take the second turn-off and turn left at the roundabout onto the B6200 to Handsworth. Asda supermarket will be on your right. Turn right at the lights after Asda (before Aldi) onto Richmond Park Road. Travel to the end and turn right again onto Richmond Road. After 500 metres the road rises slightly. The left turn into Stradbroke Primary School and Community Centre is immediately prior to a pelican crossing halfway up the rise.

FROM SHEFFIELD CITY CENTRE — Head for M1 motorway along the A57 / A630 Sheffield Parkway. Turn right towards Handsworth on the B6200 and follow the above directions.

BY BUS

Services 24 (First) and 25 (Stagecoach) leave Arundel Gate in Sheffield approximately every ten minutes. Both services stop about 200 metres from the playing venue.

PRIZE GIVING

No formal prize giving. Prizes will be paid by bank transfer.

RATE OF PLAY

BLITZ — 3 minutes plus 2 seconds increment.

RAPIDPLAY — 25 minutes per game plus an increment of 5 seconds per move from move 1. There is no requirement to record the moves.

LATE ARRIVAL FOR ANY ROUND

Players will be defaulted if they have not arrived at their board within 10 minutes of the start of the round.
Re-pairing will take place if possible.

HALF POINT BYE IN ROUND 1

Players may request a half point bye in Round 1 in either event, only if they do so at the time of submitting their entry.

A half-point bye will not be allowed in the final round and will only be allowed in other rounds at the organiser's discretion.

PAIRINGS

Pairings will be made according to FIDE Pairing Rules using the Swiss Manager program.

FIDE LAWS OF CHESS

All sections will be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess and in particular Appendix Article A.5 relating to Rapidplay events. You are strongly advised to make yourself familiar with these laws —

MOBILE PHONES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES

During a game, a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone, electronic means of communication or any device capable of suggesting chess moves on their person in the playing venue. Such devices may be stored in a bag as long as the device is completely switched off.

If you are found with a device in your possession when away from the board during your game, e.g. in the toilets, then you will lose your game and may be banned from the rest of the tournament and / or future events.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Organiser reserves the right to refuse an entry, or transfer an entry to another section, without explanation.

Unrated players cannot win a rating prize and, with the exception of the Open, may only win 50% of any other prize.

Competitors can only win one prize and prizes will be allocated as the Organiser sees fit.

The advertised prizes may be changed subject to the number of entries received.

In the event of a dispute, the decisions of the Organiser and/or Chief Arbiter will be final in all matters.
Players must agree to their rating information being published on the ECF and FIDE websites.

The submission of an entry form and payment of the entry fee denotes acceptance of the tournament's terms and conditions.
